- publishes the quarterly newsletter *The PennsWoodPusher* including crosstables, columns, reviews, articles, and games.
- sponsors a variety of state championships, including the Open State Championship held in late summer alternating between eastern, central, and western sites; the Scholastic and Quick Chess Championships held in the spring in Carlisle; the Action Chess Championship held in the fall; the Team Championships held in the winter in both Philadelphia & Pittsburgh; the Senior Championship held in the fall in Philadelphia; the Junior and Bughouse Championships held in fall in Pittsburgh; and the Annual Postal Championship beginning each February.
